



School Uniform Policy

All decisions concerning the school uniform have been recommended and fully endorsed by the School Board. In accordance with the Department of Education and the CCHS Positive Behaviour Expectations, wearing a uniform is compulsory for all students attending a Department of Education school.

It is school policy that:

- Every student will wear school uniform.
- Students arriving at school will be neatly dressed in CCHS compliant clothing.

Dress requirements for students enhance the public's image of our school and have a positive impact on a student's self-esteem. They also enhance a student's sense of belonging and pride in the school community. In addition, from a safety and security aspect, dress requirements are a useful means of identifying whether an individual on school grounds has a right to be there.

In our school, the School Board has developed a school uniform, in consultation with the families, students and staff.

All students are required to wear:

- CCHS branded Polo Shirt
- CCHS branded hoodie OR plain navy-blue hoodie
- CCHS branded shorts/pants OR plain navy-blue, shorts, pants or skirt

Uniform compliance is expected, at all times on the school grounds (before school, in all classes, between classes, break times, and after school until off school site).

All CCHS branded clothing can be purchased from Uniform Concepts Clarkson.

Any student arriving at school without correct uniform will be issued a Uniform Notice. They may be loaned a school shirt/jumper from Student Services/Front Office for wearing that day. Any clothing item loaned must be returned on that day. Parents will be contacted so that they are aware of this breach by SMS/email. Parents who are unable to provide clothes adhering to the school dress code on a particular day for an exceptional reason should contact Student Services.

If a student is repeatedly not adhering to the Uniform Policy or refuses to take off a non-school compliant jumper, contact will be made home, and a Uniform Infringement will be issued. Receiving a Uniform Infringement may require the student to attend detention with the Head of Student Services. This may result in the Loss of Good Standing, where the student will be ineligible to represent the school or attend events.

Footwear

Flat, fully enclosed footwear must be worn at all times. Ugg boots, thongs, slippers, crocs, flip flops, or sandals are unacceptable. This is a health and safety issue.
